


AN AUTHORITATIVE BIBLICAL LOOK ON COURTSHIP AND MARRIAGE

From a Missionary Linguist To Rosetta Stone FRAUD OR IGNORANCE?

"... like I learned my first language ..." If asserting that one can learn a second language like [as] he learned his first language is not deliberate fraud, then it is gross ignorance.

Rosetta Stone claims to guide language learners into fluency of the language they are learning *just* as they learned their first language.

Such a thing is impossible. First, our entire selves . . . all of us . . . change as the days, weeks, months, and years go by. Our ever-changing brains simply will not allow us to acquire a new (second, third, fourth or what have you) language as we learned our first language.

Language learning begins in the womb, as we hear those outside talk, and as we get familiar with the sounds, cadences, consonants, vowels, patterns and structures of our native language.

After birth we assimilate our native language effortlessly, even with all its complexities, intricacies, and monumental difficulties. It is indeed miraculous. But the process always takes four, five, six, or seven years to really master . . . and even then we continue to make mistakes.

But as the years go by our neurological language learning capacity changes. So now, in order to learn a second, third, or fourth language we must resort to painstaking cognitive labor, which often involves drills, memorization, translation, etc.

A Bible translator, and one of the greatest linguists of all time, Dr. Eugene Nida, even went so far . . . in his book written especially for missionaries . . . How to Learn a Foreign Language . . . to recommend the rote memorization of second language material (such as the Gospel message, a Bible story, or a spiritual truth). Dr. Nida insisted that rote memorization of narrative material would lead to mastery and fluency . . . that the frequent recitation of memorized material would create "pathways" in the brain that would never be lost.

Dr. Nida was right. How do I know? Why do I dare challenge Rosetta Stone? How am I so sure?

Simply because as a missionary I tried Dr. Nida's strategy, and it worked. After only ten months in Japan I was preaching the Gospel and teaching the Word of God in one of the world's most difficult languages without an interpreter. (A famous China missionary said, "Crowley has the gift of tongues.") Contrary to Rosetta Stone's dictum, my adult brain benefited from drills, translation, and memorization.

So, many years later, with a Master of Science degree in Applied Linguistics (Georgetown University, 1965) I can say with authority that Rosetta Stone's dictum is either knowingly fraudulent, or unknowingly ignorant.
